Prof . Ioannis Theotokas is the Secretary General of the Ministry of Maritime Affairs and Insular Policy. He is Professor at the Department of Shipping, Trade and Transport of the University of the Aegean. He has a background of economics and has specialized in Shipping Management. He received his PhD from the University of Piraeus (1997). His research interests include issues related to Management, Human Resources Management and Strategic Management applied to shipping business. He has participated as scientific coordinator or as principal researcher in research projects related to employment, entrepreneurship, strategy and competitiveness in shipping, to maritime training and e-learning, to image of shipping and in consultancy studies funded/commissioned by the European Commission, the Greek Ministry of Economic Development and the Panhellenic Seamen's Federation.

Ioannis Theotokas is the author of six books (with five as co-author) published in Greece and in the UK and of 35 papers published in international journals (which include: Maritime Policy and Management, Marine Policy, Business History, International Journal of Human Resource Management and Corporate Governance) and in edited books. He has presented over 50 Papers at international scientific conferences.
